The app works also for Drivve | DM in Version 7 with one limitation:

In this version the document preview is working for native PDF files only.

As of version 8, all document types are supported which are available in Drivve DM web browser.

Features

General

- Multiple logins for cloud or onPremise instances can be managed.
- Logout to end the current session.
- Info page to see current information about the app.
- Drivve | DM permissions are also applied in App.

Documents:

- Search documents via free search.
- Search documents via saved searches from Drivve |DM.
- · See recently used documents.
- Detail view with document properties.
- See notes or add new notes.
- See linked files.
- See linked tasks.
- PDF view for all supported document formats in Drivve |DM 8.
- Share documents as an attachment or as a link. (Also share with other apps).

Upload new Documents

Share a document on the mobile device with the Drivve |DM App. The user may provide the following attributes for the Drivve |DM upload :

- Document name
- Filing shortcut
- User Inbox
- Workflow Template

After saving, the detail view of the document is displayed in the app.

- Search spaces via free search.
- Find spaces via saved searches from Drivve |DM.
- See last used spaces.
- Detail view with space properties.
- See notes or add new notes.
- See linked documents.
- See linked tasks.
- See sub-spaces
- Share space as link.

Workflows

- See documents of your own inbox.
- See open tasks.
- See detail view of a task
- Accept task.
- Complete task.
- Share task as link.
- See documents of a task.
- See notes or add new notes.
- See linked files of a task.
